Early Ed Schools (Junior & Montessori)	• Each student will/has been provided with an individual art supply kit; no other art materials will be shared (unless sanitized) or stored in the classroom	
Middle School	 Students/teachers will sanitize their hands before entering/exiting the studios or classroom Students/teachers will wear masks at all times (unless needing a drink etc.) Student/teacher workspaces are physically distanced from each other Students will remain seated unless instructed otherwise Each student will/has been provided with an individual art supply kit; no other art materials will be shared (unless sanitized) or stored in the art studios Grade 5 and 6 art kits can remain in their home form classrooms (in their personal bin) Desks/chairs that students have used in the art studios will be sanitized after/before each class – deep cleaning will be completed by custodial staff throughout the day and evening All work will be photographed and submitted digitally Grade 7 dedicated studio has intervening periods to clean between cohorts Grade 8 studio cleaning coordinated with Middle School cleaner as a priority between adjacent classes 	
Senior School	 Students/teachers will sanitize their hands before entering/exiting the studios or classroom Students/teachers will wear masks at all times (unless needing a drink etc.) Student/teacher workspaces are physically distanced from each other Students will remain seated unless instructed otherwise Each student will/has been provided with an individual art supply kit; no other art materials will be shared (unless sanitized) or stored in the art studios Desks/chairs that students have used in the art studios will be sanitized after/before each class – deep cleaning will be completed by custodial staff throughout the day and evening All work will be photographed and submitted digitally 	

MUSIC

Early Ed Schools (Junior & Montessori)	 Physical distancing of two metres or more will be in place between all students and the teacher will be further distanced from the students when in the classroom Virtual teaching (real time synchronous) will also occur so that the music teacher does not enter the cohort's classroom every day to reduce contacts (homeform teacher remains in the classroom for supervision and support) No shared instruments/materials Students are in a single cohort and not travelling to a specialized music classroom; instead the music teacher travels to each cohort's homeform classroom Lessons include percussion and some singing, however, singing will be very minimal (i.e. call and response with individuals, short phrases with group). This greatly reduces the risk of airborne particulate transmission Percussion instruments and equipment will be individualized and not shared 	
Middle School	 Students will sanitize hands upon entering and exiting Physical distancing of two metres or more will be in place between all students and the teacher will be further distanced from the students when in the classroom Students will have their own individualized equipment (drum sticks, mallets) Students will wipe down their own chairs at the end of each class Any shared percussion instruments will be sanitized between uses Music lessons will include music appreciation, percussion (performance), music theory and composition There will be no singing (choral classes) or wind instruments for now (to be reassessed as the year progresses) 	
Senior School	 Physical distancing of two metres or more will be in place between all students and the teacher will be further distanced from the students when in the classroom Senior music classes are scheduled in the Paikin Music Room where the space is extremely large and the number of students in each class is relatively small so physical distancing has been maximized The vast majority of music students do not share instruments or equipment Any shared instruments like percussion are sanitized after each use Specialty masks designed for wind players and vocalists will be worn by the students Plexiglass barriers will be used in front of each instrument/player to further reduce chances of transmission Singing will happen outside when possible

Early Ed Schools (Junior & Montessori)	 Students will sanitize hands (washing or using hand sanitizer) before and after HPE Class Students will wear masks in the hallways Students in Grade 4 will wear masks at all times while indoors Students will practice physical distancing (six feet) using the stickers in the hallways When we are outside students will practice zombie arms or windmill arms (three feet) to maintain distance when we are walking out to the fields Students have the option of taking off their masks when we are outside Students will be allowed to take off masks only when we are exercising vigorously in the gym Students will not touch each other at any time Students will respect the personal space of others Equipment used by one cohort must be sanitized before it can be used by another Students will have designated spots identified by stickers or tape in the gym which are six feet apart 	
Middle School	 Change Room Procedures: Grade 5 students do not need to change for HPE; only students in Grades 6, 7, and 8 are required to access the change rooms Students will sanitize when they enter and exit through change room doors Students are required to check in with their PE teacher prior to entering the changeroom Students may need to remain outside on the floor markings maintaining social distancing while other students finish changing Students need to hand sanitize before entering the changeroom Students must wear their mask at all times while in the hallways and change rooms Students in even cohorts will go to the right. Boys will change in the upper Page boys' change room and the girls will change in the lower Page girls' changeroom and meet in the Page Gymnasium. Students in odd cohorts will go to the left. Girls will change in the upper Page girls' changeroom and meet in the DeGroote Gymnasium In each of the changerooms there are large social distancing stickers placed in socially distanced spaced areas. Smaller social distancing stickers are at each of the entrance hallways for all four changerooms for students to wait. The large flow stickers are posted to move traffic through the change rooms as the flow for some of the changerooms is new. The flow indicates entering from the closest door to the Lawson Hall entrance and exiting the opposite door of each of the changerooms.

Middle School	 During HPE Class: Students have designated spots in the gymnasiums that are six feet apart from the next where they are to place their PE kit bag Warm up activity, attendance and online learners will take place in gymnasium before transitioning outside For hallway transitions students need to wear their mask; once outside, students can still wear their mask or insert it into a pocket or carrying device Students must follow social distancing and equipment usage instructions from the PE teacher Water bottles and weather appropriate clothing is recommended – check the HPE Course Outline for details Students will not be sharing equipment that is passed between each other using hands All equipment is cleaned using a fogger prior to the beginning of each HPE class so that no student is handling any equipment that has not been sanitized Students must wash their hands after the HPE class is over and they have finished changing back into their school uniform
Senior School	 Change Room Procedures: Students need to hand sanitize before entering the changeroom and after exiting the changeroom Students will also sanitize hands intermittently during class when sharing equipment with other students Students must wear their mask at all times while in the hallways and changerooms and until instructed to remove them once class begins Students in each class have been assigned a changeroom to ensure the minimum number (sixe to ten) in each room – this number is based on page 5 of the following document found at ontario.ca Students have designated spots in the changerooms that are six feet apart from the next in which to place their PE kit bag In each of the changerooms there are social distancing stickers placed in socially distanced space dareas. Students enter the changeroom, get changed quickly in one of the allotted spaces, leave their bags in the allotted space inside the changeroom and spray down the space they used after changing back into their school uniform at the end of class. Students sanitize hands upon exiting the changeroom and come to the assigned meeting space (gym, field, blacktop, etc.). During HPE Class: Warm up activity, attendance and online learners will take place in gymnasium before transitioning outside

Senior School	 For hallway transitions students need to wear their mask, once outside, students can still wear their mask or insert it into a pocket or carrying device Students must follow social distancing and equipment usage instructions from the PE teacher Water bottles and weather appropriate clothing recommended – check the HPE Course Outline for details Students will be sharing equipment that is passed between each other using the hands. Students will be reminded frequently not to touch their face and to follow proper hygiene. Equipment is sanitized before every class, as well as intermittently during class, where appropriate All equipment is cleaned using a fogger/stericide spray bottle prior to the beginning of each HPE class so that no student is handling any equipment that has not been sanitized Students must wash their hands after the HPE class is over and they have finished changing back into their school uniform Students must sanitize their hands upon re-entry into the senior school
