A Winning Formula to Begin Construction

On September 16th, 2010 the HSC community gathered in the Artsplex Theatre for a lively update on the College's progress with the 'Transformation HSC' capital campaign, and to publicly launch the 'Family Campaign.' Last April we reported that our \$34 million project was already funded to the \$15,000,000 level through donations and pledges. We can now revise this number up to almost \$19,000,000. In addition, the Campaign Steering Committee is actively working with prospective donors on additional, potential contributions in excess of \$4,000,000, and is confident that we are winning this campaign!

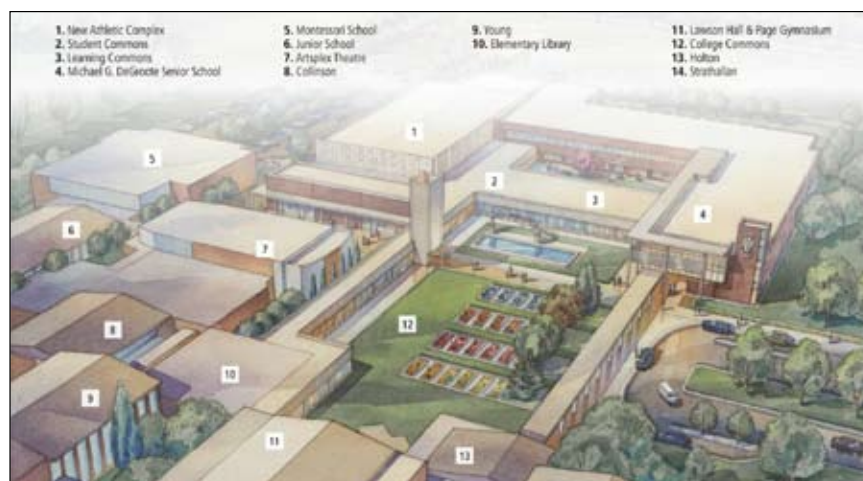
Campaign Chair, Mr. Ron Foxcroft, reported that the \$23 million in donations, pledges and expressions of support that we now have puts the campaign at the 70% mark. "If we can close the gap on the fundraising goal in the coming months, the Board of Governors could be in a position to allow construction to begin by the spring of next year," said Ron.

"We have always been huge supporters of HSC and the Transformation Project is proof that our patronage has been a very worthwhile investment."

Family Campaign Rocks!



Donors to the HSC Family Campaign will receive prominent recognition

Launched quietly last January, the **Family Campaign** is showing breathtaking successes in just a few short months. At the public launch event last month co-Chairs and current parents Agnes Kuskowski '82 and Jeff Paikin' 80 proudly announced that in nine short months this campaign had raised \$962,000 from parents and alumni. "Contributors to the Family Campaign are pledging their support over one to five years, sometimes longer, in the \$25,000-\$50,000 range," said Jeff. "And since all gifts are tax-deductible, that can bring the net cost of a \$25,000 gift down to as little as \$276 per month over five years."

"The initial and most urgent goal of the Family Campaign is to raise an additional \$2 million by Spring 2011," reported Agnes. "If just 80 families come forward at the \$25,000 level we can reach that goal," she added. In fact, as some families are making gifts of \$50,000 or even \$100,000, the actual number of additional donors to the Family Campaign may be even less than eighty to reach that immediate goal.

When do the Bulldozers Arrive?

While it might impact our sports activities and the campus traffic for a while, we are all eager to see the Transformation HSC project underway. The Board of Governors is awaiting the arrival of the final costing on this project, due in the coming weeks. In January they will meet to review whether sufficient funding, pledges and financing are in place to allow us to order the bulldozers to HSC to begin construction in the Spring.

Our job today is to bring sufficient additional funding to the table to allow them to make that decision, without unduly encumbering the College financially. Please consider joining the Family Campaign before January to help bridge the gap!

An elegant lounge area in the Lobby of the new Senior School will be the home of a stunning digital montage, allowing us to showcase donors, the new buildings, student achievements and much more.

We anticipate that the majority of Family Campaign donors will be current families, alumni families and grandparents.
