General Information

Program Cancellations

HSC reserves the right to limit enrollment and change instructors when appropriate. The College also reserves the right to combine or cancel camps due to insufficient enrolment or due to the unavailability of instructors or facilities. We cannot guarantee additional sessions when enrolment surpasses expectations, so please register early. In addition, HSC reserves the right to cancel a camp one week before the start date. In such cases, all fees for a cancelled camp/session will be refunded.

Refund Policy

All requests for refunds must be made in writing. Refunds, less a \$25 administrative charge per cancellation, will be issued for all camp cancellations up to two weeks before the first day of camp. Pro-rating and refunds are not available for days absent or for any other reason.

Refunds are not available within the 2 week period prior to the first day of a camp session.

Free Extended Service

The HSC Summer Programs run from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. We are pleased to provide an Extended Service that operates from 8:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. The campers are supervised while participating in a variety of activities.

Note: The Extended Service closes at 5:00 p.m. Any child not picked up by 5:00 p.m. will be taken to the Summer Programs Office, where a \$25 late pick-up fee will be charged per child.

For Safety's Sake

To ensure participants' health and safety, please make camp staff aware of any medical conditions, medication requirements, behavioral issues or allergies. This information is valuable and will help ensure a rewarding camp experience for the participant.

Expectations for Behaviour

Campers must be in the correct camp for their age as of July 1st, 2012. We reserve the right to move campers to an age-appropriate camp.

While applications submitted to the Summer Programs Office will be processed as quickly as possible, please be advised that camp availability cannot be guaranteed.

General Information

The Trojan Sports Skills Camp philosophy is to teach the fundamental sports skills of each sport offered, and to individualize the instruction to meet the needs of each sports camper. Each camp will consist of a variety of training activities which will encourage participants to learn new skills, refine and develop existing skills, while enhancing the participant's self-esteem.

Our sports camp staff consists of experienced teachers/coaches from the Hamilton and surrounding area. Our player to coach ratio is 10:1. Trojan Sports Skills Camps use facilities at Hillfield Strathallan College and Mohawk College and other facilities in the Greater Hamilton Area. Transportation is provided as required.

Trojan Combative Camp NEW

Combative Camp for kids focuses on improving all components of physical fitness including muscular endurance, strength, flexibility, coordination, agility, reaction time and cardio-vascular endurance. Participants will play combative games in addition to learning proper wrestling techniques in a fun and safe environment. The Director of this Camp is Ms. Melissa Mancini, a member of the faculty at HSC where she also coaches wrestling to students in both the Middle and Senior Schools. Ms. Mancini is a two-time Provincial Wrestling Champion.
